#### **Bell UH-1H Iroquois (Huey)**

The UH-1 was the first turbine-powered helicopter produced for the military and it was first designated as the HU-1A, hence the nickname "Huey." These helicopters first saw combat during the Vietnam War in 1963 and became the most common utility helicopter in Vietnam from 1965 to 1973. The Huey provided various methods of support including assaults, cargo transport, medical evacuations, and search and rescue.

The Huey helicopter displayed In the Eagle Air Museum was constructed in 1964, but it is unknown if the helicopter was used in Vietnam. It was last flown by the California National Guard before being brought to Bonanzaville on April 8, 1999.
